

GTXmedical Privacy Statement and Cookies

General

GTXmedical is very committed to safeguarding your privacy and protecting your personal data. Your personal data will be processed for the assignment you have given us.

Third parties

GTXmedical will handle your personal data with care and will only provide it to third parties if this is necessary or if GTXmedical is legally obliged to do so. GTXmedical is not responsible or liable for the way in which third parties handle your personal data.

Storage period

GTXmedical does not keep your personal data longer than necessary for the purposes for which it is processed, unless this is necessary to comply with legal obligations.

Processing of personal data

By using the services on www.gtxmedical.com, you provide your personal data to GTXmedical. On the web page we might ask you to at least fill in your name and e-mail address. We need the aforementioned data so we can contact you.

If you subscribe to a newsletter on the website of GTXmedical, we ask for your name and e-mail address so that we can send you our newsletters.

GTXmedical may also process this data for marketing purposes.

If you respond to a vacancy and send in your CV, GTXmedical will process this data to complete the application process.

GTXmedical does not give any personal data to third parties, unless GTXmedical is legally obliged to do so, or such provision is necessary to perform the service you have requested.

Processing purposes

The personal data that GTXmedical processes is exclusively used for the following purposes:

- for responding to questions and comments
- for providing the services offered
- for sending newsletters and invitations
- for analysing and improving our services
- for conducting market research for the benefit of GTXmedical
- for carrying out application procedures
- for dealing with complaints

GTXmedical may also process your personal data to comply with legal and regulatory obligations. Your personal data will only be processed differently if you have given GTXmedical your explicit consent to do so. This permission may be expressed by the mere fact that you have submitted a question to GTXmedical by e-mail or otherwise.

Cookies and passive tracking

GTXmedical uses cookies. A 'cookie' is a data element that is sent to your browser. Your browser can then store it on your system, according to the preferences you have set in your browser. Cookies collect information about your operating system, including, but not limited to, the browser type and Internet Protocol address, or IP address.

GTXmedical uses cookies to:

- make the website suitable for your personal interests
- ensure that the basic functionality of the website works properly
- generate user statistics in an anonymous way to make the website more user-friendly

GTXmedical uses this information to analyse the traffic on our website, to view both the page views and the time spent on each page, and to serve you better when you return to our website.

It is not our intention to use this data to personally identify a user. This data is collected in an aggregated and anonymous way. You can configure your internet browser to notify you when you receive a cookie, so that you can decide whether or not to accept this. Furthermore, you can block all cookies. Please note that if you refuse or block cookies in any way, you may not be able to use all the features available on the website. Certain parts of the website may not function if you block cookies.

Google Analytics

The GTXmedical website uses Google Analytics. This is a service provided by Google Inc. Google Analytics is a web analytics service that uses cookies to analyse the use of our website. These cookies are used to store visitor information, for example the duration of your visit to our website. Google may provide this information to third parties anonymously.

Changes

GTXmedical reserves the right to change the privacy statement and use of cookies at any time. These changes will be published on the GTXmedical website. You can find the latest version on our website. We therefore advise you to check this web page regularly to see if any changes have been made.

GTXmedical may process your personal data for new purposes that have not yet been mentioned in this Privacy Statement. In that case we will contact you before processing your data for these new purposes to inform you of the changes in our regulations for the protection of personal data and to give you the opportunity to refuse the use of your data for those purposes.

Hyperlinks

We draw your attention to the fact that our website contains hyperlinks to other websites. This Privacy Statement and use of Cookies does not apply to the linked websites.

Questions and rights

Would you like to have access to the personal data that we process from you, or would you like to have your personal data corrected, supplemented or deleted? You are entitled to do so! We may however ask you to identify

yourself adequately with an identification document. For this purpose, we ask you to make your photo and social security number unrecognisable. We may also ask for further information to fulfil your request, such as sending you documentation. We will meet your request for inspection, correction, supplementation and deletion within a reasonable period of time. This reasonable period is no later than four weeks after your request and identification.

You may also object to any processing of your personal data, for marketing purposes, at any time. Finally, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority if your personal data are unlawfully processed. For details, please visit their website:
